

Biography – Henry Nasrallah, MD, DLFAPA

Dr. Henry Nasrallah is a widely recognized neuropsychiatrist, educator and researcher. He served 18 years as chair of psychiatry at The Ohio State and Saint Louis University, and 4 years as Associate Dean at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, where he is currently Vice Chair for Faculty Development and Mentorship, Professor of Psychiatry, Neurology and Neuroscience, Medical Director of Neuropsychiatry Program and Director of the Schizophrenia Program

Dr. Nasrallah has published 14 books, 720 scientific articles and 630 abstracts. He is Editor-In-Chief of 3 scientific journals. He is a Distinguished Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association and has received 43 research and teaching awards including National Educator of the Year by the Psychiatric Times and the highest faculty awards at OSU and UC. He is ranked in the top 1% of world researchers in terms of his publications being cited. He established the CURESZ charitable foundation to serve and advocate for the seriously mentally ill and their families. He is listed annually in the book “Best Doctors in America”.
